STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Account statements are sent via email weekly from the District Office. All payments (including tuition, extended daycare, late pick-up fees, extracurricular activities, and any other miscellaneous charges) are due on the 1st of the month. Payments are applied against the oldest charges on the account and cannot be designated for specific charges. If accounts are not paid in full by the end of each month, your student's participation in extra-curricular activities, as well as their continued enrollment may be in jeopardy. If you fall behind on making a payment, please contact the District office immediately! They will assist you with your account and can help to setup a modified payment plan, if needed.

Check or Money Order	Make checks payable to our school. Please be sure to write the student name in the memo line and turn in with completed payment coupon.
