For your home

Technology (Chromebook / iPad for example) is a powerful tool for learning, and we are excited about the possibilities for our students. While they are on campus, we have the AUP (Acceptable Use Policy) and the Digital Citizenship Agreement to help guide and protect our students.

We know you want the same at home; to that end, we recommend creating a family Home Acceptable Use Plan (HAUP) with your child. To help in this, we are offering a framework of a HAUP from which you can begin a discussion and customize your own plan.



Decide together on:

- Family approved Apps
- Times and places for Technology (Chromebook / iPad) usage
- General principles of online integrity
- How to be safe, balanced, and accountable
- Specific expectations for social use
- How to respond to harmful content/messages
- How to give proper attribution (identifying the source or author of written material) and respect
- When and how purchases can be made

Recommendations (as you design your HAUP)

Demonstrate

- That you are not afraid of the technology (Chromebook / iPad) use it with your child
- An interest in your child's online work and presence
- An attitude of love and caring concern for your child's online activity

Communicate

- A vision for what responsibility and good use of the Chromebook / iPad looks like
- A plan for accountability and random checks of the technology
- Boundaries, if the technology should stay in shared spaces (not behind closed doors), for example.
